Dear GLMM Tournament Team:

Thank you for registering to play in the 2010 Glen Lake Mighty Mites Tournament. The GLMM host teams welcome your participation and we plan to make it a great event for players, coaches, and fans.

Awards: Individual trophies will be presented to the first, second and third place teams. Any team in these categories that roster more than 12 players will receive the additional trophies within 10 business days after the tournament is complete.

Location: All games will be played at the Glen Lake Optimist Fields. We've got a great baseball facility with fields that have grass infields, elevated mounds, six-foot fences and scoreboards. The Glen Lake Optimist Fields are located at 14350 Excelsior Boulevard, Minnetonka, MN 55345, at the northeast corner of the Excelsior Boulevard and Woodhill Road intersection.

Concessions: There are concessions and indoor bathrooms at this complex. Please check out our concession stand for refreshments – this

patronage helps keep our tournament costs down and allow us to not charge teams a gate fee. PLEASE NOTE, the Glen Lake Mighty Mites strictly prohibit alcoholic beverages and / or tobacco on the complex grounds. Please do not make us enforce these rules as the offender will be required to leave the park.

Rosters: Please BRING a completed Glen Lake Mighty Mites team roster to the fields along with copies of your players' birth certificates when you check in prior to your first game. We will not retain any birth certificates. The official roster form is attached. Please provide a cell phone for at least 2 coaches.

Coaches,

We're very excited for you all to be a part of the 2010 Glen Lake Mighty Mites 12U AA Tournament, Thursday July 29, 2010 - Sunday August 1, 2010.

Please read through this email and attached documents in their entirety for key information that you will need.

- Welcome/Introduction Letter with key information about the tournament
- Roster Form that you need to fill out prior to sign-in and bring with you to check-in. Do not reply your roster to me via email. You MUST have your roster to check in.
- Tournament Rules
- Tournament Bracket

Each game the umpire will bring a Game Summary Sheet with them to the field. After the coin toss determines which team is Home and Visitor, the Home team will need to take the sheet and fill it out HOME and VISITOR and keep track of the pitchers for each team for the duration of the game. Please record first initial, Last Name and the jersey number. We will be keeping track of the pitchers used per the attached rules. At the end of the game, please fill in the final score, have both head coaches sign and give back to the umpires - they will turn into the field supervisor to record on the tourney sheet at the concession stand.

We will allow the pitchers a 5 pitch warm up between innings and when a new pitcher comes in the game, if your catcher isn't ready you can use a coach to catch. NO MORE THAN 5 pitches will be thrown for warm up on the field. Please make sure your players are hustling on and off the field between innings.

*CHANGE IN GAME TIME RULE: Due to the number of teams we have in this tourney and the city agreement we have regarding play on the fields with lights, we will utilize a 1 hour 45min hard time rule for the games. Any game that is playing at 1 hour 45 min will be called and the score at the end of the last inning will be recorded. Additionally, this will give us the time needed to prep the fields for the next game.*

Please review the rules prior to your games; the Umpires will be enforcing them. You will need to check in with the FIELD SUPERVISOR at the concession stand when you arrive. Please be prepared to give them your roster and show them your

birth certificates. You will need to provide one game ball, but please be prepared to toss the Ump an additional one during a game should there be several homeruns hit to keep the pace of the game going.

You have access to the batting cages one hour prior to your game time. You do not need to reserve cages as we have 4 on site for your use.

Per our rules, it is the head coaches responsibility to make sure your coaching staff, players and fans abide by good sportmanship behavior. In the case of inclement weather we will do as much as we can to continue to get all games played - which includes the possibility of suspending a game while waiting out the weather. Please respect our field supervisors as their time on our league board is strictly volunteer and it is their job to make sure all players have a fun and safe opportunity to play as much ball as they can during the tournament. If you have any questions or issues, please have your head coach contact our Tournament Directors.

If you have problems during the tournament, please only have one representative from your team contact the field supervisor at the field - you can check at the concession stand for that person.

**PLEASE NOTE: WE WILL NOT BE TAKING ANY CALLS OR EMAILS FROM PARENTS.** If your team has any questions - they need to direct to the coaches and you can contact me; we will only respond to one coach.

Our fields **prohibit the use of tobacco and/or alcohol on the park.** We welcome encouraging team cheers and appreciate your assistance in keeping your parents in line with this. Please address your team parents if there are any discouraging or disruptive cheers to other teams. We would hate to have to ask a parent to leave the tournament because they are breaking the rules, but we have done it in the past. ***Please make sure your parents understand these policies.***
